Lima, March 16th, 2020.- TASA, a company affiliated to the National Fisheries Society (SNP for its Spanish acronym), announced its membership as a partner to the Global Sustainable Seafood Initiative (GSSI), a public-private organization that seeks to face sustainability challenges through sector collaboration in order to promote sustainable fishing products for all.
